### Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975 amendments


Note: these amendments will come into effect upon proclamation by the Governor-General.

- 1. On 5 March 2018 the Governor-General gave Royal Assent to a Bill which makes amendments to the *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975* to implement a new governance model. Under the new governance model, the Authority will consist of up to seven members including:
  - a. an independent part-time Chairperson of integrity, national credibility and standing who would not be perceived as representing a Reef interest group;
  - b. a full-time CEO; and
  - c. five other part-time members including continuation of at least one member who must be an Indigenous person with significant knowledge or experience in Indigenous matters relating to the Marine Park and at least one member who must have significant knowledge or tourism expertise associated with the Marine Park. One member will also continue to be nominated by the Queensland Government.
- 2. The amendments introduce new provisions that seek to reduce the potential for conflicts of interest. The amendments provide that a person is not eligible for appointment to the Authority if they are a *member of a governing body* of a *relevant interest group*.
  - a. A relevant interest group is one that <u>represents one or more groups of people</u> who:
    - i. are directly involved in <u>advocating views</u> in relation to the management of the Marine Park; or
    - ii. use the Marine Park for commercial purposes.
  - b. The Authority manages the Marine Park, including through issuing permits and developing zoning plans and plans of management which affect what particular individuals or organisations are permitted to do within the Marine Park.
- 3. It would be inappropriate for a person to be a member of the Authority if that person's work or public occupation involves *lobbying or advocating policy or actions to governments* that are clearly intended for specific benefits for themselves, or their organisation. However an individual is eligible for appointment if they are merely a member of a relevant interest group and not involved in the management of that entity.
- 4. The amendments also prevent appointees from <u>undertaking paid work that is in conflict</u> with their duties as a member of the Authority. For example, if a person receives <u>income</u> <u>for undertaking activities</u> which are <u>regulated by the Authority</u>, it would not be appropriate for them to <u>make decisions</u> relating to the <u>regulation</u> of <u>such activities</u>.

# **Key Points:**

- The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Amendment (Authority Governance and Other Matters)
   Act 2018 introduced a new governance model for the Authority. This includes separating the
   Chairperson and Chief Executive Officer roles currently held by Dr Russell Reichelt into two
   positions, creating an additional part-time Board member position and introducing new
   provisions to reduce the potential for conflicts of interest.
- 2. The final step for this Act to become operational is proclamation of the commencement of Schedule 1 (the Board governance components) by the Governor-General. Appointment of a Chairperson and an acting Chief Executive Officer is then required to fill the resulting leadership positions. The proposed commencement date for Schedule 1 and these appointments is 29 October 2018. This date has been agreed by Dr Reichelt and Dr Poiner.

- 4. The Federal Executive Council minute at <u>Attachment A</u> proposes proclamation of the commencement of Schedule 1 of the Great *Barrier Reef Marine Park Amendment (Authority Governance and Other Matters) Act 2018*, to take effect on 29 October 2018. The proclamation instrument is at <u>Attachment B</u> and the explanatory memorandum for this item is at <u>Attachment C</u>.
- 5. The Federal Executive Council minute at <u>Attachment D</u> proposes the appointment of Dr Poiner as Chairperson of the Authority for a period of four years and six months, commencing on 29 October 2018. The appointment instrument is at <u>Attachment E</u> and the explanatory memorandum for this item is at <u>Attachment F</u>.
  - a. By signing these documents you are certifying to the Governor-General that Dr Poiner has significant knowledge and experience in marine science and that he is not a member of a governing body of a relevant interest group, as defined by s10(9) of the amended *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975* which will take effect on 29 October 2018.
    - i. The Department has been unable to find anything that clearly establishes that Dr Poiner would be ineligible for appointment as a part-time member once the amended Act commences. Refer also paragraph 9 of this brief.

# Sensitivities and Handling

- 8. New provisions to reduce the potential for conflict of interest in the Authority will come into force with commencement of Schedule 1 of the Act. A person will not be eligible to be appointed to the Authority's board if he or she is involved in managing a 'relevant interest group' for the Reef (s10(9)) which is also an ongoing requirement (s15B). In addition, the Chairperson and other part-time members must not undertake any other paid work that, in your opinion, conflicts or could conflict with the proper performance of their duties (s15A).

- 9. Any perceived conflicts associated with Dr Poiner's prior roles will be actively managed. Dr Poiner has indicated that he will publicly announce his intention to resign from his current role as Chair of the Reef and Rainforest Research Centre if he is appointed as Chairperson of the Authority. This is anticipated to take effect in early November 2018, after the Centre's next Annual General Meeting.
  - a. The Centre receives funding from the Authority for the crown-of-thorns starfish control program and from the Department for advice on Reef 2050 Plan matters. This presents a potential for criticism of Dr Poiner on perceived conflicts – which he will need to actively manage.

# EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Minute No. of 2018 - Minister for the Environment

Subject - Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975

Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority – Part-time Chairperson –

Appointment 2018

The *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975* (the Act) establishes the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority (the Authority), which is responsible for the management of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park (the Marine Park). Its key functions are to advise and make recommendations to the Minister in relation to care and development of the Marine Park; develop zoning plans and plans of management; manage the Marine Park collaboratively with the Queensland Government; conduct research; and provide education, advisory and information services.

Schedule 1 to the *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Amendment (Authority Governance and Other Matters) Act 2018* (the amendment Act) amends the Act to replace the existing full-time Chairperson position with a part-time Chairperson and full-time Chief Executive Officer, and creates one additional part-time Board member position. A separate minute to the Executive Council recommends a proclamation be made fixing 29 October 2018 as the date on which this Schedule commences.

Subsection 10(2) of the Act, as amended, provides that the Chairperson and members, other than the Chief Executive Officer, shall be appointed as part-time members by the Governor-General.

Subsection 10(6) of the Act, as amended, provides that a member shall be a person with significant knowledge of, or significant expertise concerning, one or more of 10 fields related to the functions of the Authority. New section 10(9) of the Act provides that a person is not eligible for appointment as a part-time member of the Authority if, at the time of appointment, the person is a member if the governing body of a relevant interest group.

Subsection 11(1) of the Act, as amended, provides that a part-time member shall hold office for the period specified in the instrument of appointment, which must not exceed 5 years.

The Minute recommends the appointment of Dr Ian Poiner as Chairperson of the Authority for a period of four years and six months from 29 October 2018<sup>1</sup>. The appointment would be made in accordance with section 4 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* which enables the amended appointment power to be exercised in the period between the amendment Act receiving the Royal Assent (on 5 March 2018) and the commencement of Schedule 1. The proposed duration would stagger the expiration of Chairperson and Chief Executive Officer terms by approximately 12 months, which would support smooth transitions in future. The current full-time Chairperson is filled by an acting appointment of Dr Russell Reichelt, which will cease when a new Chairperson is appointed.

Dr Poiner is a highly respected marine scientist with international science credentials and experience with managing global programs. He has board leadership experience involving change management and complex stakeholder relationships. He has a long history of involvement in Great Barrier Reef science and conservation and a demonstrated ability to engage with local community and present credibly on the ecology of the Reef.

Dr Poiner's curriculum vitae is attached.

The Minute recommends that the appointment be made in the form proposed.



It is my pleasure to announce Dr Ian Poiner has been appointed as Chairperson of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority (GBRMPA).

Dr Poiner has been appointed under the new Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority board arrangements introduced in the *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Amendment (Authority Governance and Other Matters) Act 2018*, which come into effect today.

Dr Poiner is a highly respected marine scientist with international science credentials and board leadership experience. He has a long history of involvement in Great Barrier Reef science and conservation, and is a former CEO of the Australian Institute of Marine Science. I have no doubt he will make a significant contribution to the continued health and resilience of the reef.

Dr Poiner has resigned from his role as the Independent Chair of the Reef and Rainforest Research Centre to take up this important position and replaces the dual Chairperson and CEO Dr Russell Reichelt, whose term is concluding.

I am grateful to Dr Russell Reichelt for his contribution to the Authority as Chairperson and CEO for the last 11 years.

Dr Reichelt is an outstanding scientist and marine park manager. He has successfully managed the world-renowned Great Barrier Reef Marine Park over a time of significant environmental challenges and has implemented many substantial measures to improve the management of this world famous icon.

Significant reforms for the Authority were announced in November 2017, in response to the independent governance review by Dr Wendy Craik AM.

The Government accepted all 24 recommendations to further strengthen the Authority and position it to best meet the significant challenges facing the Great Barrier Reef.

The legislative amendments that take effect today also strengthen the conflict of interest provisions in the *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975*.




