### India – Labelling requirements

The Department of Agriculture has been notified that the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) is verifying at the time of import that products comply with its legislation for food labelling, and that products that use sticker type labels may not be deemed to be acceptable.

The Draft Regulation on Labelling (Claims) 2013 refers to a "label" as any tag, brand, mark, pictorial or other descriptive matter, written, printed, stenciled, marked, embossed graphic, perforated, stamped or impressed or securely affixed to the container, cover, lid or crown of any food package. According to this regulation, stickers may only be permitted for making declarations (if not preprinted) regarding name and address of the importer, date of manufacturing and / or packing and vegetarian / non vegetarian logo.
