Taiwan	Pharmaceutical and technical products – Ox gallstones	8.4	New Entry – new export certification established

Country	Commodity	Section	Explanation
Canada	Fish	1.2, 4.1, 7.	Updated - production, documentation and access for fish and fish products information updated.
India	Fish	6.1, 6.2,	Updated - labelling and use-by-date requirements for fish and fish products updated.
