

EU accredited properties may only receive breeding females from a non accredited property with the approval of the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry. Non-EU breeding females remain in the system as not eligible for the EU but their offspring will be eligible.

The cattle must have been born and bred on the farm of origin, be NLIS identified on that property, and attested to be HGP free. You may purchase cows, heifers or pregnant females. Cows with calves at foot are not permitted.

Once approved, the purchased cattle must be identified on the NLIS database as not EU eligible. The transfer must be notified to the NLIS database in the usual way and a list of the animals Radio Frequency Identification Device (RFID) numbers must be sent to AQIS.
