We have no record of any AWIRs being submitted by ^{s. 47G(1)} s. 47G(1) so far in 2024. A response to Elise must emphasise that it is the primary responsibility of the establishment to identify these issues, the OPV may not have known anything about it. The Land Transport Standard does have a standard that the receiver of livestock must dispose of dead stock, but unlike the guideline which follows, the standard does not stipulate that this includes any dead stock on the vehicle.

Land transport **standard** SA5.17

- * The receiver of livestock must make arrangements at the first reasonable opportunity for separating weak, ill or injured livestock for rest and recovery, appropriate treatment, or humane destruction and **disposal of dead stock**.

Guideline GA1.4

- * The person at the destination is responsible for the livestock from the point of unloading and notification of livestock being received. This responsibility should include but is not restricted to:
 - * removing dead stock **from the vehicle**

Neither the model code of practice for pigs or the code of practice for the welfare of animals – Livestock at slaughtering establishments have any provisions for establishments removing dead animals from trucks or the need to record them.

The industry animal welfare standard also makes no comment on recording or dealing with dead on arrivals.
