The cooked poultry meat has a refrigerated shelf life no greater than 5 days (includes frozen cooked poultry meat that has a refrigerated shelf life of no greater than 5 days once thawed).

You can validate that the level of *Listeria monocytogenes* will not increase by greater than 0.5 log cfu/g over the stated shelf life of the cooked poultry meat.
