Vietnam	Fish and fishery products	1.1, 1.2, 1.4, 7.1, 7.2	Pages updated in line with existing market access requirements. This is a MICoR update only and no new requirements have been advised for trade in seafood products to Vietnam. Please refer to FISH MAA2014-04 for more details.
