Market Access

- In 2019-2020, approximately \$12.8 million worth of edible kangaroo meat was exported to 15 countries by four export establishments.
 - The top three markets for kangaroo meat by value in descending order were s22(1)(a)(ii) and United States of America (\$0.4 million).

• From 1 January 2016, Australia no longer has market access for kangaroo meat and inedible products (skins/hides) to California, United States (US).

• Australia still has market access for kangaroo products to the rest of the US. s22(1)(a)(ii)
