The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) has received informal advice that the UAE may have introduced revised export certification requirements for fish and fishery products.

DAFF is currently clarifying this situation with UAE officials.

In the interim, <u>prior to exporting</u> fish and fishery products to the UAE, exporters are advised to seek confirmation from their importer that their consignment will be accepted into the UAE using the current FX46 certificate.
