Export Health Certification for Seafood Exported to Hong Kong

Following the introduction by Hong Kong of revised import requirements, effective 1 December 2010, consignments of seafood (including bivalve molluscs such as oysters) exported from Australia to Hong Kong must be accompanied by an **FX46HK** certificate with **endorsement 4621**, issued via EXDOC. This one government certificate and endorsement will cover all types of seafood exported to Hong Kong for human consumption.

Approved Arrangements (AA)

All AQIS-approved establishments and vessels which undertake processing, as defined in the *Export Control (Fish and Fish Products) Orders 2005*, are eligible to export fish and fish products to Hong Kong. Amendments to your documented food management system to include the above importing country requirements may be required.
