Manual of Importing Country Requirements (MICoR) - Fish/Seafood

MICoR is an information management system that brings together the importing country requirements of Australia's agricultural export trading partners on to one single platform.

MICOR is a web-based database with standard web navigation to search for content on importing country requirements for fish and seafood. MICoR does not require special training as it is a standard web navigation tool.

To use and view data in MICoR, you do not need any specific software on your computer. You need a connection to the internet using any standard browser e.g. Explorer, Firefox, Safari etc. MICoR can also be accessed using mobile devices with internet connection.

The MICoR system is now available for use via the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry website. You can now search importing country requirements, access advanced search functionality and save and/or print content relevant to your operational needs.

Some of the content in MICoR is restricted and, as a result, a logon and password will be required to view specific restricted content. Users will need to go to the MICoR homepage to 'apply for access'; http://www.daff.gov.au/micor/fish/apply for access

All applications for access to MICoR are processed by the DAFF Dairy, Eggs and Fish Program.
