

Submit a separate questionnaire for each product intended for export to Australia with the import permit application. Commercial-in-confidence information should be marked as such by the manufacturer and the questionnaire returned directly to the Animal and Biological Imports Branch (ABIB) via email to imports@agriculture.gov.au.
What you must know	 The Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment may contact overseas government competent authorities to verify any information provided in this questionnaire. It is a criminal offence under the Criminal Code Act 1995 to knowingly give false or misleading information to a Commonwealth officer exercising powers under Commonwealth law. This offence carries a potential penalty of 12 months imprisonment. Consider all information provided in this questionnaire carefully. Failure to complete the questions or provide supporting documentation will result in delays in the processing of the import permit application.

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

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


