1. Acceptance of terms and conditions

Your use of the Spreadsheet Model is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this document and any changes to this document that Biosecurity Australia may publish from time to time (collectively, the "Terms of Use"). Please read the Terms of Use carefully before proceeding to request the Spreadsheet Model. In order for You to be provided with the Spreadsheet Model and a password, the following Terms of Use (as amended from time to time) <u>must</u> be accepted under section 2 of the request form. If You do not indicate that You agree to be bound by the Terms of Use, You will not be provided with the Spreadsheet Model.

2. Use of software

In order to access the Spreadsheet Model, You will need to use @Risk software ("Software"), a commercially available software program. You must ensure that You are permitted or otherwise licensed to use the Software. Use of the Software is governed by the terms of the license agreement that accompanies or is included with the Software.

4. Use of Spreadsheet Model

You may view, download, and print the Spreadsheet Model subject to the following conditions:

- i. the Spreadsheet Model may be used solely for the purpose of assisting You (including your employees and other authorised persons), to prepare a submission to Biosecurity Australia for the Revised draft import risk analysis report for apples from New Zealand in respect of an application from New Zealand to export apples to Australia;
