# Document processing email update and closure

#### Who does this notice affect?

All clients currently lodging import documentation for biosecurity assessment via email.

#### For information

This information is following on from <u>Industry Advise Notice 12/2016</u>.

As of 30 March 2016, the Cargo Online Lodgement System (COLS) will be used to lodge all Full Import Declarations.

As a result, the <a href="mailto:nationalquarantine.processing@agriculture.gov.au">nationalfood.processing@agriculture.gov.au</a> email will be discontinued for all Full Import Declarations and Upgraded Self Assessed Clearances.

The following commodities will be exempt from lodgement into COLS and will need to be sent to our new importassessment@agriculture.gov.au email address:

- Carnets
- Military Consignments
- Personal Effects
- Ship Stores
- Transhipment Requests

In addition communication relating to the below will remain open within the new email address for:

- Imported Food Laboratory nomination forms
- Overtime booking requests
- Payments (subject to the above commodities)

The <a href="mailto:sacnce@agriculture.gov.au">sacnce@agriculture.gov.au</a> email will continue to operate and will also now include:

- All Upgraded Self Assessed Clearances
- Movement Advice for Animal Transport Equipment
